
HOW TO USE YOUR TOILET IF SEWER SYSTEM IS DOWN


- 1 Turn off water supply from valve next to toilet.
- 2 Empty water from bowl & tank by scooping out to save gray water or try flush & plunge out.
- 3 Sanitize toilet; use Clorox or Lysol-type product
- 4 Plug drain hole to prevent sewer gas escape. Need a malleable shape that can trap gas. Three suggestions were: a. Old rags smothered in Crisco and stuffed into a stocking; b. Rice covered in vaseline stuffed into a form; c. Kitty litter or dirt filled balloon.
- 5 Lift seat, slide open kitchen garbage bag over bowl and fit in place; secure with strip of tape.
- 6 **For urination**: place urine hat across front of toilet, put seat down and urinate. Empty into sealable container such as 5 gallon bucket.
- For defecation: remove urine hat and defecate in garbage bag-lined bowl. Sprinkle with poo powder, sawdust or kitty litter. You can keep material in lined toilet for several uses and then remove entire bag and place in <u>sealable</u> container. Alternative: remove each time with pet poo bags. Put pet poo bags in container.
- 8 WAIT for disposal instructions from authorities.

Supplies:

Disposable vinyl gloves; kitchen garbage bags; poo powder; wide tape; urine hats; doggie poo bags; large, lidded containers (round <u>5 gallon</u> container, large kitty litter container, etc); large bag to cover entire toilet; method to plug toilet gases. Toilet paper and hand sanitizer.

Keep lid down when not in use; Cover entire toilet in large black bag
