

***To obtain a General Mobile Radio Service (GMRS) license, you need to register for an FCC Registration Number (FRN) (if you don't already have one), then apply for the license through the FCC's Universal Licensing System (ULS). The process involves registering for an FRN, logging into the ULS, selecting the "General Mobile Radio Service" option, completing the application, and paying the associated fee.***

Here's a more detailed breakdown:

1. Register for an FCC Registration Number (FRN):

- If you don't have one, you'll need to register for an FRN through the Commission Registration System (CORES).

2. Apply for the GMRS License:

- Log in to the FCC's Universal Licensing System (ULS) using your FRN and password.

- Answer the questions in the application, providing personal information and confirming your application.

3. Pay the License Fee:

- Follow the prompts to complete the payment process.

4. Download Your License:

- Your GMRS license will be ready for download within 24 hours.
