



EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT LISTS FOR PETS



1. Records of current vaccinations from your vet including microchip numbers, registration, and current license information in waterproof bag/container
2. Water and Bowls – 8 to 17 ounces of water per 10 pounds for 15 - 30 days
3. Food and Bowls for 15 – 30 days with feeding instructions
4. Manual can opener
5. Pet Carriers / Crates / Pillow case for treatment of cats
6. Blankets, towels and toys
7. Litter, disposable pans and plastic liners
8. Disinfectants and cleansers to handle animal wastes
9. Fire resistant leashes, collars, muzzles and harnesses
10. Photos of you and your pet together
11. Toys



First Aid Kits for Pets

1. Prescription medications and instructions for specific pet (name)
2. Saline solution for eyes and eyedropper or syringe
3. Self-cling bandages, Adhesive tape and scissors
4. Antiseptic wipes, creams, sprays or ointments
5. Absorbent gauze pads / Sterile non-stick gauze pads
6. Ice pack
7. Tweezers and Needle nose pliers
8. Disposable razor
9. Hydrogen peroxide to induce vomiting – 1 tsp per 10 lbs of body weight (dogs)
10. Ichthammol ointment (drawing salve)
11. Benadryl for allergic reactions – 1mg per pound of body weight 2 – 3 times daily



First Aid Kits for Large Animals

1. Leg wraps for horses
2. Duct Tape & Wire Cutters
3. Lime and bleach disinfectants
4. Fire resistant non-nylon leads and halters
5. Food required for 15 – 30 days = 1 – 2% of body weight per day of hay / hay-like product
6. Water = 5 – 15 gal per day for 15 – 30 days
7. Ear tags or Body painted identification



KEEP PETS CONFINED IF YOU LEAVE THEM HOME. PETS SHOULD BE INDOORS IN FAMILIAR SURROUNDINGS (car, etc)
